Dr. Kuether is a board certified Neurosurgeon and performs both brain and spine surgery. Dr. Kuether is currently the director of neurotrauma at Legacy Emanuel Hospital.

He served as Assistant Professor of Interventional Neuroradiology at Dotter Interventional Institute (OHSU 2000-2001) and has been in private practice in Portland for the last 14 years. Dr. Kuether is a member of the American Association of Neurosurgical Surgeons and Congress of Neurological Surgeons. He is board certified in Neurosurgery.

Dr. Kuether's active interests include minimally invasive spine surgery, brain and spine tumors, kyphoplasty, and both cervical and lumbar artificial disk replacement. He has received additional training in endovascular surgery and specializes in the treatment of cerebrovascular diseases including aneurysms, stroke, and carotid stenosis, angioplasty, and coils.
